TREATMENT CHARGES

Fertility Assesment & Investigations

As we are an NHS hospital your initial consultations and diagnosis are free of charge, as are follow-up consultations after your treatment. Some patients may qualify for NHS funding of their fertility treatment. NHS funding is organised by your primary care trust, who will decide if you qualify for funding. It is important to be aware that each primary care trust sets their own criteria for funding and some do not offer funding for fertility services at all. Check with your GP to see if funding is available in your area.

Detailed below are the current costs of treatments/procedures.
Please note certain treatments require separate purchase of medications.

UNDERSTANDING THE PRICE STRUCTURE

THE PRICES FOR IVF AND ICSI INCLUDE:

- All pre treatment visits
- All ultrasound scans
- Egg Collection
- Embryo transfer
- Freezing of any surplus embryos

If your treatment is not completed due to OHSS and your embryos are frozen, the price will include your first frozen embryo transfer cycle.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED: (SEE PRICE LIST FOR COSTS)

- Viral screening (HIV, Hepatitis B and C)
- All drugs
- All necessary fees requires by the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority.
- Freezing of Oocytes within a standard treatment cycle
- Storage and maintenance of frozen embryos

CYCLES ABANDONED BEFORE EGG-COLLECTION (IVF AND ICSI)

Your treatment may have to be abandoned if:-

- You do not respond to the drugs and there are no or very few follicles developing.
- You over respond to the drugs, therefore egg collection and continuing treatment is thought to raise your risk of OHSS
- You are not fit to proceed with the treatment for any reason.
- You decide not to continue with the treatment

If this happens, there will be a charge of £750.00, to cover the cost of the treatment you have received.

DONOR SPERM BACK UP

If patients require donor sperm back up, charges will apply whether or not the sperm is used. See separate donor sperm price sheets.

FEES FOR FROZEN EMBRYO TRANSFER INCLUDE:

- All pre treatment visits
- All ultrasound scans
- Any necessary drugs (up to your pregnancy test)
- Embryo transfer

ABANDONED CYCLES (Frozen Embryo Transfer)

If the lining of your womb does not thicken in response to the drugs, even after the dose has been increased, your treatment may be abandoned before you reach embryo transfer. If your embryos fail to thaw your cycle will be abandoned. In these cases there will be a charge of £500.00 to cover the cost of the treatment and drugs that you have received up to that point.

FEES FOR OVULATION INDUCTION INCLUDE:

- All pre treatment visits
- All ultrasound scans
- All monitoring blood tests

FEES FOR INTRAUTERINE INSEMINATION (DONOR OR PARTNER) INCLUDE:

- All pre treatment visits
- All ultrasound scans
- Sperm preparation and insemination

FEES FOR EGG DONATION (IVF OR ICSI) FOR EGG SHARER

As per IVF & ICSI but fees also include any necessary drugs. If your treatment is not completed due to OHSS (please see treatment information sheet) and your embryos are frozen, the price will include your first frozen embryo transfer cycle.

FEES FOR EGG DONATION (IVF OR ICSI) FOR RECIPIENT

- All pre treatment visits
- All ultrasound scans
- Embryo transfer
- Freezing of any surplus embryos (freezing eggs is not included)
- All necessary drugs (up to your pregnancy test)

WHEN & HOW DO I PAY FOR TREATMENT?

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE THE INVOICE?

You will be given an appointment to attend a consent signing session prior to starting your treatment. An invoice will be sent to your home, one to two weeks prior to your appointment. This should be paid when you attend the Birmingham Fertility Centre for the consent signing appointment.

You are requested to make payment by debit/credit card or cheque, where possible. If paying by cheque, treatment cannot commence until the cheque has cleared.

REFUND POLICY

If for any reason your treatment cycle is abandoned and you have paid for your treatment, you will be entitled to a refund. The refund due to you will be the fee for the treatment that you have started less the abandoned cycle fee.

On the day that your treatment is abandoned the Doctor/Nurse will inform the accounts office. The accounts office will organise a refund to be sent to you by cheque in the post from our finance department based at University Hospital Birmingham who aim to have your refund with you within 14 working days.

Unless requested the cheque will be made payable to the female partner.

DRUG PRICES

It is impossible to give an accurate drug price before you have a full diagnosis as the drug dose is dependant upon your age, hormone profile and other factors. Currently for IVF / ICSI it would be in the range of £400 to £1800 depending upon your drug dose and duration of your treatment stimulation. If you decide to be treated by Birmingham Fertility Centre we will provide you with an individual price breakdown of the cost of drugs before you start treatment.
